I-95: Take exit 167 and turn toward Etna (ME-143 N) at the end of the ramp. Proceed on ME-143 N about 4.7 miles to New Sweden Rd (on the left).

There is a sign for the Penobscot Longrifles on the corner.

New Sweden Road is easy to miss!!

It is soft so be careful.

Look for the "Pointing Dog" to help guide you.

Take the New Sweden Road to the club house on the left (about 0.75 miles).
